TELUGU BASHA VAROSTSAVALU


The HOD of Telugu Department conducted 'Telugu Basha Varostsavalu'in our college from 22.08.2023 to 29.08.2023.

The Head of Telugu Department ,Dr.S.Gulab Jan ,principal,Dr.L.Anjali Devi and other staff members attended the programme.


Dr.S.Gulab Jan ,vice principal and Head addressed on the occasion that the birthday of "Shri Gidugu Rama murthy" been celebrated as Telugu Basha Dinotsavam' in Andhra and Telagana states. His contribution for promoting Telugu language during British Empire . He was a Telugu writer and one of the earliest modern telugu linguists and social visionaries. He championed the causes of using a language comprehensible to the common man (Vyavaharika Basha) as opposed to the scholastic language (Grandhika Bhasha)

Telugu Language Day is celebrated on 29th August every year to commemorate the birth anniversary of Gidugu Venkata Rama Murthy ,who was born on 29th August 1863 in Srikakulam District, a Telugu poet freedom fighter and social reformer .
